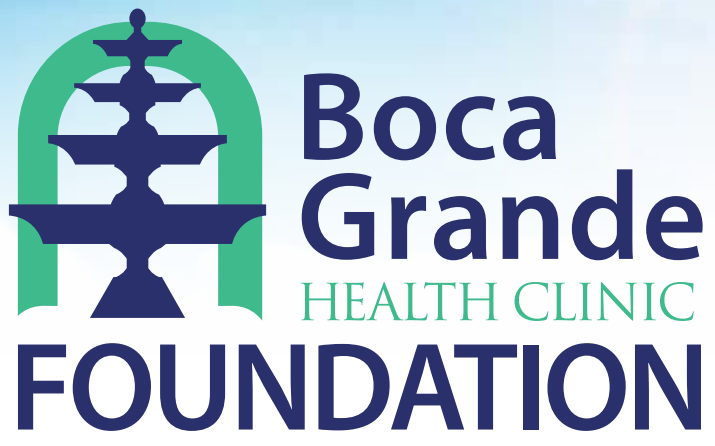

This was a year of transition as we built a strong leadership team and planned for a broader representation on the Board of Trustees. With Bill Ghriskey as head of the Investment Committee, Skip Branin as Treasurer, Mary Anne Hastings as Secretary/Executive Director, Dan Bayly as Fundraising Chair, Diane Mayer as Annual Giving Chair, Jim Runde as Audit Committee Chair, and Susie Tinsley, Liz Verney, John Jackoboice and Peter Powell heading our Auction and Golf committees, respectively, we are in a strong position to take the Foundation forward. We are excited to welcome Mary Howell as our Chair of Endowment Gifts this fall.

We are also responding to the changes in our donor base. As newer residents seek to support the mission of the Clinic, we are responding with a refined message and better online access to our mission and financial needs. I hope you will visit our new website soon to see the changes we have made.

We have made substantial progress on our \$5 million capital campaign and hope to complete it this year. The two commercial and three residential properties held by our organizations are being updated through this effort, including the recently completed renovation on the Clinic "Annex" building. We are grateful to the families who have committed to the campaign.

We fully appreciate that our donors value the high-quality services provided by our Clinic as well as the services available through the independent healthcare providers in the Annex building. While currently in a strong financial position, the Foundation is undertaking a long-range plan to ensure that we have sufficient funding to support any future plans the Clinic may have.

We have also added over 20 families to our Healthnetwork Membership through this campaign. This is a valuable recognition of our appreciation to those who make major donations to the Foundation from \$25,000 to over \$500,000. This membership offers access to the most prestigious medical institutions in the U.S. including: NY Hospital for Special Surgery, Cleveland Clinic, Dana Farber, Mayo Clinic, Johns Hopkins, MD Anderson among others. This year the Foundation needs to raise approximately \$2.8 million to support both the Clinic operation and our own expenses. The Boca Grande Health Clinic: Then, Now, And Tomorrow

It has been said that more changes have occurred in the practice of medicine in the past 50 years, than in the entire history of modern health care dating back to the 4th century BC and the time of Hippocrates. In the 70 some years the Clinic has been in existence there have been enormous changes in the way medicine is practiced on Boca Grande that parallel the changes that have occurred in health care throughout the world.

When the clinic was chartered in 1947, it was housed in a room on the top floor of the railroad depot. Now the Clinic resides in a state-of-the-art medical facility with an electronic medical record system, x-ray capability, a support staff of highly trained and caring nurses and health care workers. The recently renovated Clinic annex leases space to four health care providers, a dermatologist, and physical therapists. It will soon add ultrasound to its diagnostics. The renovation will provide much needed additional space for the Clinic's own physicians to care for patients.

The first Clinic doctor came once a week to the island from Arcadia by railroad car and saw only a handful of patients. Now the clinic is staffed by three board certified physicians.

Drs. Hana, Ervin, and James live on the Island and are available to patients 24 hours a day, every day of the year. They treat over 5,000 patients annually and make house calls.

In its infancy, the Clinic had no means of measuring its quality and no accreditation.

Now it monitors its quality and adheres to best practice protocols, and it is accredited by the prestigious Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care.

The original Clinic board set a goal of raising \$2,000 a year to cover the expenses of running the medical practice. Currently the Clinic is multimillion dollar operation funded by a foundation established by farsighted citizens of the Boca Grande community.

So what does the future hold for the Boca Grande Health Clinic? The trends in medicine that will occur in the next decade and will impact the Clinic are evident. There will more patients to treat. There will be technology advances that will change the way patients are cared for. Information will dictate how medicine is practiced. There will be a change in the way providers are reimbursed. And of course, there will be increased costs.

To prepare for these changes, the Clinic's board of directors is embarking a long range planning process that will prepare us to meet the medical needs of the Boca Grande Community in the years ahead. While there are uncertainties about the future, one thing is certain. Adapting to the changes that will allow the Clinic to continue to provide high quality health care will cost money. That means the Clinic Foundation's ability to fund the Clinic will be essential in allowing the Clinic to continue practicing state-of-the-art primary care.

The Clinic staff and board are deeply appreciative of those who support us through their gifts to the Foundation.

Q: Should I be concerned about water quality on Boca Grande?

A. Though we have not seen any “flesh-eating” bacterial infections first hand over the summer here at the Boca Grande Health Clinic, we have had a lot of questions that were prompted by the stories in the news media. There are a few bacteria that can cause this type of infection, also referred to as necrotizing fasciitis, and the infection does not have to be picked up in salt water. Most of these infections, not related to salt water, will be caused by a group of bacteria called Streptococcus. We may see this in any wound, including surgical site wounds. A second group of bacteria called Vibrio vulnificus is associated with the infections in beach goers that are seen with saltwater exposure, especially exposure to warm, brackish (a mix of fresh and salt) water. In 2019, Lee County has had only one

confirmed case of Vibrio infection and Charlotte County only two confirmed cases and no one has died as a result of these cases. (The most cases for 2019 have been in Pinellas County and totaled six). Those with chronic diseases like diabetes and kidney disease or with suppressed immune systems are particularly susceptible.

Another concern for local beach goers and vacationers alike is the “Red Tide,” a harmful bloom of the algae *Karenia brevis* that produces a neurotoxin. This neurotoxin can cause fish kills and can build up in shellfish and when aerosolized by the breaking surf, it can cause irritation of the eyes and throat, a dry cough and even nausea in people and pets. The effects can be even more severe in those with underlying allergies, asthma or other lung conditions. This summer the levels of *K. brevis* have been background or low and we have not seen any dead fish littering our Boca beaches. Avoidance is the best treatment for Red Tide and washing off with soap and water and going into an air conditioned environment works best for relief of the symptoms. The Florida Fish and Wildlife website updates their map with water samples that measure the concentration of *K. brevis* each Friday and this can be found at www.myfwc.com.

The Florida Health Department website, www.floridahealth.gov, displays results of routine bacterial monitoring through the Florida Healthy Beaches Program. Weekly samples are monitored for the bacteria *Enterococcus*, and counts are listed on the website along with any advisory notice.

So, the bottom line is, the water out there has potential to be dangerous. Be sure to follow these general rules of thumb:

■ **DO NOT WADE OR SWIM IN WATER WITH ANY OPEN WOUND.** If you are wounded while in the water, be sure to wash the area thoroughly with soap and water and monitor for any signs of developing infection. See a doctor if you notice any concerning changes.

■ **KEEP YOUR TETANUS STATUS UP TO DATE.** There are a lot of bare feet and flip flops around here and in combination with rusty nails, fish hooks and beaches full of shells, it's important to be sure you remain protected while enjoying our beautiful island.

Annex Services

Since 2006, the building across the street from the Boca Grande Health Clinic known as “The Annex” has housed medical services not offered by the Clinic itself. While the building and its practitioners served the community well, the structure needed to be refurbished and new health care regulations and accreditation standards needed to be adhered to. Therefore, the clinic board, with the blessing of its Foundation, embarked on a plan to renovate The Annex. In the spring of 2019, an architect with expertise in construction of medical facilities was engaged and a builder hired to carry out his plans. The work was done expeditiously over the summer so the building would be available for patients seeking its services when the season commenced in the fall of 2019.

The centerpiece of the Annex has been the physical therapy department. The number of patients that use its services has grown to approximately 1,500 per year. To accommodate the increase demand for therapy, the space available to the therapist was expanded and an exam room added to provide patient privacy. Fitness Quest Physical Therapy, the organization that provides physical therapy services, has agreed to add an additional therapist to their staff. The building’s restrooms have been enlarged and remodeled to better accommodate patients and to comply with the Americans for Disabilities Act. A conference room for Clinic and Foundation staff meetings has been created as well as a space with technology for patient education and medical presentations to small groups. The building’s three exam rooms have been extensively remodeled. New flooring and cabinetry have been installed to comply with infection control regulations. Secure storage of medical records has been made available to adhere to HIPA patient privacy rules. Fresh paint and new furnishing have brought the rooms up to contemporary standards. These exam rooms will be utilized by the Clinic’s own board certified physicians, Doctors Lauren Hana, Tom Ervin and Ray James as well as private practitioners who have leased space in the building for the past several years. They include Tim Corey M.D. a Dermatologist, Nancy Blackstone R.N., Ph.D. a Psychologist, Noel Crosby Au.D. an Audiologist, Cecelia “Cheech” Hill DOM, LMT, CNMT an Acupuncturist, and Micheal McCormick DPN a Podiatrist. The Annex building and its activities will now be overseen by a full-time employee of the Clinic. Like all facets of the Clinic’s operation, these improvements have been made possible by the contributions of generous donors to the Boca Grande Health Clinic Foundation.

The Boca Grande Health Clinic’s mission is to meet the primary healthcare needs of the residents, workers, and visitors of the Gasparilla Island community. The renovation of the Annex is another endeavor by the Clinic to fulfill its mission by providing convenient, high quality health care to those it serves.

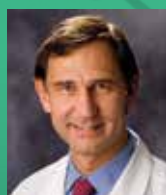
